1 2	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for award of grants.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 7813(b) of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 7813. Award of grants.
8	* * *
9	(b) Limits
10	(1) Except as provided in paragraph (3), grants shall be
11	not less than \$2,500 and not more than \$15,000 per fire
12	company.
13	(2) Grants may be awarded on a pro rata basis if the
14	total dollar amount of the approved application exceeds the
15	amount of funds appropriated by the General Assembly for this
16	purpose.
17	(3) In a municipality where there are two or more

volunteer fire companies and if two or more volunteer fire companies consolidated their use of equipment, firefighters and services [within five years preceding the date of the current year application submission deadline], the <u>following</u> <u>apply:</u>

6 <u>(i) The</u> consolidated entity shall be deemed eligible 7 to receive a grant not to exceed the amount of the 8 combined total for which the individual companies would 9 have been eligible had they not consolidated.

10(ii) The individual companies that consolidated11shall each be eligible to receive an individual grant not12to exceed the amount which the individual companies would13have been eligible had they not consolidated.
