AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the payment of death benefits to the surviving spouse or children or parents of firefighters, ambulance service or rescue squad members, law enforcement officers or National Guard members who die as a result of the performance of their duties," providing for the payment of death benefits.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section $1(a)$ of the act of June 24,1976 (P.L.424, No.101), referred to as the Emergency and Law Enforcement Personnel Death Benefits Act, amended October 9, 2009 (P.L.588, No.51), is amended to read:

Section 1. (a) In the event a law enforcement officer, ambulance service or rescue squad member, firefighter, certified hazardous material response team member or National Guard member dies as a result of the performance of his duties, such political subdivision, Commonwealth agency or, in the case of National Guard members, the Adjutant General, or, in the case of

1 a member of a Commonwealth law enforcement agency, the
2 authorized survivor or the agency head, within [90 days] three
3 years from the date of death, shall submit certification of such
4 death to the Commonwealth.
