10	Section 1. Section 1(a) of the act of June 24, 1976
11	(P.L.424, No.101), referred to as the Emergency and Law
12	Enforcement Personnel Death Benefits Act, amended October 9,
13	2009 (P.L.588, No.51), is amended to read:
14	Section 1. (a) In the event a law enforcement officer,
15	ambulance service or rescue squad member, firefighter, certified
16	hazardous material response team member or National Guard member
17	dies as a result of the performance of his duties, such
18	political subdivision, Commonwealth agency or, in the case of
19	National Guard members, the Adjutant General, or, in the case of

a member of a Commonwealth law enforcement agency, the
 authorized survivor or the agency head, within [90 days] <u>three</u>
 <u>years</u> from the date of death, shall submit certification of such
 death to the Commonwealth.

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6 SECTION 2. THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1(A) OF THE ACT SHALL
7 APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHOSE DATE OF DEATH OCCURS BEFORE, ON OR
8 AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.
