

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 490 Printer's No. 481

Prime Sponsor: Baker Committee: Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness

SYNOPSIS:

Requires Senate confirmation of the director of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency.

SUMMARY:

Amends Title 35 (Health & Safety) by making the Director of the PA Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) subject to the consent of the majority of the members elected to the Senate.

Requires the Governor to nominate a person for the position of director within 30 days of the effective date of the bill.

Effective Date: Immediately.

BILL HISTORY:

Senate Bill 637 of 2007/08 was unanimously reported by the Senate Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness Committee.
