

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 602 Printer's No. 716

Prime Sponsor: Barrar

Committee: Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness

SYNOPSIS:

Increases the active duty pay for National Guard personnel from \$75 to \$100 per day.

SUMMARY:

HB 602 would amend Title 51/Military Affairs by increasing the minimum state active duty pay for PA National Guard personnel from \$75/day to \$100/day.

The term "state active duty" applies to periods when the Governor activates the Guard for disasters and emergencies, in a non-federally declared event.

Effective Date: Immediately

BILL HISTORY:

HB 602 was unanimously passed by the House. Act 139 of 1996 increased the pay figure from \$45 to \$75.
