SYNOPSIS:

Joint State Government Commission Study of Military/Veterans Benefits.

SUMMARY:

Senate Resolution 255 would require the Joint State Government Commission to conduct a study on behalf of Active, National Guard and Reserve Service Members, Veterans, and their families. The Commission would be required to:

- 1. Review and provide a listing of all services, benefits and programs offered by state agencies.
- 2. Survey veterans service organizations and compile a listing of services and programs.
- 3. Survey secondary schools and institutions of higher education and provide a general listing of services and programs.
- 4. Compile a listing of federal benefits.
- 5. Review and compare other states' services, benefits, and programs, and make recommendations to consider and how to administer current programs more effectively.
- 6. Provide a report and directory to the Senate outlining services, benefits, and programs with the name of the providing entity, the eligibility requirement and the appropriate contact information for each service, benefit, and program.

Effective Date: The Resolution would take effect immediately and the Commission would have one year to complete the study.
