SYNOPSIS:

House Bill 2148 would amend the Enforcement Officer Disability Benefits Law -- or Heart & Lung Act - by adding/covering several classes of Professional Firefighters.

SUMMARY:

Amends the Enforcement Officer Disability Benefits Law -- or Heart & Lung Act -- by extending the coverage of benefits to include the following:

- *Firemen employed by the Commonwealth.
- *Paid Firemen not employed by the Commonwealth.
- *Emergency medical services personnel employed within a city fire department.
- *Firemen of airport authorities, including Fire suppression instructors.
- *Fire and Safety Marshals employed by the Commonwealth.
- *Fire academy instructors and employed by the State Fire Commissioner.
- *Assistant fire marshals employed by the Commonwealth.
- *Forest patrolmen and forest technicians employed by the Commonwealth.

Effective Date: 60 Days.

BILL HISTORY:

HB 2148 was passed by the House by a vote of 184-10.
