

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 165 Printer's No. 129

Committee: Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness

SYNOPSIS:

Creates two military decorations.

SUMMARY:

House Bill 165 would amend Title 51 (Military Affairs) by:

- *Creating the "Pennsylvania Achievement Medal."
- *Creating the "Pennsylvania Veterans Service Award."
- *Allowing the Governor to present the Pennsylvania Distinguished Service Medal which is for "meritorious service beyond the normal dictates of duty to this Commonwealth" to veterans and civilians. It is currently only open to active members of the Armed Forces, National Guard, and Reserves.
- *Allowing the Governor to present the Pennsylvania Meritorious Service Medal which is for "meritorious service rendered this Commonwealth and while holding a position of great responsibility" to veterans. It is currently only open to active members of the Armed Forces, National Guard, and Reserves.
- *Allowing the Adjutant General to issue guidelines in addition to regulations to establish the qualifications for awarding the medals; such other decorations, medals, badges, or awards; and specifications and designs for decorations, medals, badges, and awards.

Effective Date: 60 Days

BILL HISTORY:

HB 165 was passed by the House 185-12 on March 21, 2017. In the 2015-16 Session, HB 1727 passed the House 195-2 and was unanimously reported as committed by the Senate Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness Committee.
