

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 798 Printer's No. 1078

Prime Sponsor: Alloway Committee: Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness

SYNOPSIS:

Changes the membership qualifications for the PA Military Community Enhancement Commission.

SUMMARY:

SB 798 would amend Chapter 4 (PA Military Community Enhancement Commission) of Title 16 (Commerce) by allowing the one member at the "senior level of the military" to be a one- or two-star military officer (currently he/she is to be a 3- or 4-star military officer) and to be a resident of Pennsylvania (currently there is not a residency component).

Effective Date: 60 Days.

BILL HISTORY:

Act 161 of 2014 created the PA Military Community Enhancement Commission. The changes proposed in SB 798 have has not been introduced in prior sessions.
