

He held both company and field grade commands and staff level positions in the Pennsylvania Army National Guard to include the following; Fire Direction Officer, Executive Officer, Battery Commander, Fire Support Officer, Battalion S3 and Executive Officer. He served as Effects Coordinator, Deputy Fire Support Coordinator and Commander, Company A, Operations, 28th Infantry Division. Colonel Heasley served as Fire Support Coordinator prior to his current assignment as Chief of Staff, Headquarters Support Company, Headquarters, 28th Infantry Division, Harrisburg and deployment in Kuwait.

Colonel Heasley was born in Clarion, Pennsylvania in March 1969. He graduated from Clarion University, Clarion, Pennsylvania, with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration. He also graduated from United States Army War College, Carlisle, Pennsylvania, with a Master of Strategic Studies.
