Colonel Claudia S. Malone serves as the Commander, 111th Mission Support Group, Pennsylvania Air National Guard, located at the Horsham Air Guard Station, Horsham, Pennsylvania. She is also the Joint Force Commander of Pennsylvania Task Force-South.

Colonel Malone graduated from Wilkes College in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Computer Science in 1987, and was simultaneously commissioned through the Reserve Officer Training Corps as a Second Lieutenant. She earned a Certificate in Human Resources Administration from Villanova University in 1992. She later received a Master of Science Degree in Management Science/Operations Management from Temple University in 1996. She completed the United States Air Force Administration Officer School and the United States Air Force Management Engineering School (Distinguished Graduate) at Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi in 1988.

Colonel Malone's civil service career began in 1987, when she joined the Air Force Logistics Management Engineering Team (AFLOGMET), Dover Air Force Base, Delaware as a Manpower Management Engineer. In 1990, she joined the Naval Air Warfare Center-Aircraft Division, Warminster, Pennsylvania as a Personnel Systems Manager, and in 1993, she joined the 111th Fighter Wing as the Ouality Management Officer. In her military capacity, Colonel Malone was assigned in 1988 to the 709th Military Airlift Squadron (512th Military Airlift Wing, United States Air Force Reserves Classic Associate), Dover Air Force Base, Delaware, where she was the squadron's Operations Administration Officer. In 1991, Colonel. Malone began her military tour at the then-Willow Grove Air Reserve Station, joining the 270th Engineering Installation Squadron as an Electronics Officer. In 1993, she moved to the 111th Mission Support Flight as an Education Officer. In 1997, she became the Wing's Director of Personnel, and in 2000, she became the Wing's Executive Officer and Community Manager. She assumed Command of the 111th Communications Flight in January, 2002. She was a member of the Air National Guard Communications Field Advisory Committee for eleven years, finishing her term as the CFAC's Chairman. In 2013, she was selected to stand up the Wing's new Cyberspace Operations Squadron. In 2015, Colonel Malone moved to the Office of the Wing Inspector General. In 2016, she assumed command of the 112th Cyberspace Operations Squadron. She deployed in support of Operations DESERT SHIELD and DESERT STORM.
