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- Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 11 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 12 § 5312.2. Legislative Budget and Finance Committee study.
- 13 (a) Requirement.--The Legislative Budget and Finance
 14 Committee, in conjunction with the Joint State Government
- 15 <u>Commission and the Local Government Commission, shall study the</u> 16 <u>following and make recommendations with respect to:</u>
 - (1) Determining any efficiencies that can be gained in the current 911 system or potential efficiencies that can be gained with a different 911 system.
 - (2) Reviewing operations in other states, the amount of funding that the other states provide through all funding sources, including the State funding per capita, and the makeup of the local share.
 - (3) Options for the consolidation of county 911 systems, including the option of regional task forces proposed by the agency.
 - (4) Options to allow 911 system employees to work from home.
 - (5) The use of artificial intelligence in a 911 system, including recommended standards.
