

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 1304 Printer's No. 1426

Prime Sponsor: Solomon

Committee: Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness

SYNOPSIS:

HB 1304 would extend the 911 Law until January 31, 2029, and increase the 911 Fee to \$1.97 with an annual increase based on inflation.

SUMMARY:

The bill would amend Title 35 (Health & Safety) – Chapter 53 (911 Emergency Communication Services) – Section 5306.2 (Uniform 911 Surcharge) by:

- *Increasing the 911 surcharge from \$1.65 to \$1.97 a month.
- *Adding an annual adjustment based on the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) as reported by the U.S. Department of Labor.
- *Extending the sunset date of the surcharge by five years to January 31, 2029.

Effective Date: 60 days.

BILL HISTORY:

HB 1300, which would extend the 911 law until December 31, 2024, was passed by the House on October 4, 2023.
