23 Section 2. The definition of "firefighter, ambulance service  
24 or rescue squad member or law enforcement officer" in section 2  
25 of the act, amended October 6, 2005 (P.L.319, No.59), is amended  
26 and the section is amended by adding a definition to read:

27 Section 2. The following words and phrases when used in this  
28 act shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless  
29 the context clearly indicates otherwise:

31 "Department." The Department of General Services of the

2 "Firefighter, ambulance service or rescue squad member or law  
3 enforcement officer" means a firefighter; a member of a  
4 volunteer fire company; a member of an ambulance service or  
5 rescue squad; a peace officer as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 501  
6 (relating to definitions); a public servant concerned in  
7 official detention as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 5121 (relating to  
8 escape); an officer or employee of a State correctional  
9 institution; guards or employees of county jails and prisons;  
10 campus police as defined in section 2416.1(d) of the act of  
11 April 9, 1929 (P.L.117, No.175), known as The Administrative  
12 Code of 1929, or campus police as defined in section 2001-A(20)  
13 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the  
14 Public School Code of 1949; or any other law enforcement officer  
15 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or of any political  
16 subdivision thereof.
